

2023 Highlights

SeniorAge Area Agency on Aging (SeniorAge) works to assist seniors in many different ways, such as transportation, medical, food, and home safety. In 2023, SeniorAge assisted 9,070 seniors in Greene County promoting independence, mental health, and safety. For example, one gentleman was struggling with chronic infections, weakness, and frequent hospital readmission. After losing his wife, he was facing loneliness and isolation and was at high-risk of future falls and injury. SeniorAge was able to provide him with a Show Me Systems pendant that he can wear and activate if he falls at home. Further, SeniorAge assisted in getting this gentleman to his local senior center where he could enjoy fellowship with other seniors and a great noon meal. Similar stories are happening throughout Greene County as a result of the work of SeniorAge. For example, SeniorAge, through partnerships with local Greene County senior centers, provided over 64,000 meals in 2023.



The Ash Grove Senior Center offered a salad bar to seniors in 2023 that provided fresh vegetable and salad options to increase the quality and choices available to seniors at their noon meal service. Further, in 2023, they upgraded their HVAC system to make their facility more comfortable and enjoyable for patrons. The Ash Grove Senior Center provided more than 13,000 instances of service to seniors in 2023!

Seniors who utilize the various senior centers in Greene County also get the opportunity to participate in activities. The Fair Grove Senior Center hosts "Jam Sessions" where seniors get to enjoy music and fellowship.
